Disha is celebrating Vivekananda Jayanthi Celebrations since 8 years with an intention of spreading the message of Swami Vivekananda to the youth of this country. This year DISHA celebrated in a unique way by reaching out to institutions to conduct one-hour session on "Transforming Indians to Transform India". The session included a talk on the Life and message of Swami Vivekananda as a patriotic monk for half an hour and the second half dedicated for a video interaction which focused on the session title.
